On the morning of August 18, 2023, a fast-moving EF-1 tornado tore through Highland Memorial Park Cemetery, snapping trees in half and leaving a trail of uprooted century-old trees, downed branches, and other destruction along a wide swath through 20 of the cemetery's 150 acres.

The storm destroyed 20 garden areas and 125 cherry blossom, oak, pine, and walnut trees. Thankfully, human casualties were avoided but the loss of property and mature trees was devastating.

Decide if you want a memorial plaque. Your

loved one's or family's name will be imprinted on black anodized aluminum plaque with gold

lettering, staked at the base of the tree or in the garden area.

Established in 1928, Highland Memorial Park is a nonprofit, non-denominational garden cemetery whose hallmark is peace, serenity and reverence. Unlike traditional cemeteries, there are no upright headstones other than in the Family Estate section, rather lawn-level markers and special garden areas are used to memorialize the gravesites. Of the 150+ acres, half are developed into 32 sections that serviced 28,000 burial spaces. Features include a chapel and mausoleum, and numerous gardens and plantings add to the Park's natural beauty. Pre-need and cemetery estate planning services are available for families the Cemetery serves throughout the state.
